Members claiming to be part of the *Anonymous* movement are posting the addresses and maps to police officers' homes on the Internet. *Anonymous* members are using data vendors' websites to obtain the addresses and other personal information about the officers they are coming in contact with at demonstrations.

Anonymous has also hacked the websites of law enforcement agencies and accessed personal information of police department personnel and police association members.

PolicePrivacy.com recommends taking advantage of California Government Code 6254.21 to remove officers' personal information from data vendor's websites.
