Do you use your cell phone at work?

PolicePrivacy.com has received information that certain district attorneys and defense attorneys are issuing discovery requests to obtain police officers' cell phone records.

Requests are being made for officers' cell phone records who might have been present during certain arrests. The records requested include subscriber information, calls and texts of any responding or assisting officers. This information (if obtained) can be turned over to defense attorneys.

Police department attorneys and professional standards personnel usually appeal the requests.

Use caution when using your cell phone at work.
