Most of the information obtained from Spokeo.com appears to be from social networking sites and open-source databases. **PolicePrivacy.com strongly recommends that officers do not participate in social networking sites.** If you have a social networking site; set your settings on PRIVATE. We also strongly recommend the use of P.O. Boxes and alternate mailing addresses when registering your information online.
